I am writing to you to state my opposition to Duke Energy's high tension mission of a natural gas pipeline through numerous densely populated greater Cincinnati communities (Case number 16-0253-GA-BTX). I live in one of those densely populated communities. I live in Pleasant Bridge.

The sobering reality of what could happen in one of those communities if Duke Energy's gas pipeline failed would be catastrophic loss of life and total devastation. There have been explosions. Since 2010, the federal government has reported 35 explosions at

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transmission pipelines. One such example of a devastating explosion happened in San Bruno, California in September, 2010.

I am appalled at Duke Energy's total disregard for the people living in these established communities. I and my family do not want or deserve to be put in jeopardy to provide natural gas to people living in Mexico.

Please listen to my very fearful concern for my family, home and community. We do not deserve to live in fear of a devastating explosion.
