Dear Ohio Power Sitting Board,

I am a resident of Sycamore Township in Hamilton County. I am writing because I OPPOSE the Central Corridor Extension Gas Pipeline as proposed by Duke Energy Ohio.

In its current form, the natural gas Pipeline project posses an unnecessary health and safety risk to Sycamore Township residents and other communities as it will go right through our neighborhoods. In fact, the pipeline could go though people's yards, a hospital, places of worship and even an elementary school.

Moreover, Duke Energy has NO EXPERIENCE running a 30 inch high pressure industrial transmission lines through residential neighborhoods. At 720 pounds per square inch of pressure, these pipelines are dangerous. Certainly, having one in our neighborhood would impact property values.
