**REVIEW AND RECOMMENDATION
SUBMITTED ON BEHALF OF THE STAFF OF
THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF OHIO**

On July 29, 2016, Cincinnati Bell Extended Territories LLC (CBET) filed an application to add a new Service, Cincinnati Bell Ethernet Service (BES) Silver in Section 22 of its carrier-to-carrier tariff. CBES Silver is a port based, point-to-point Ethernet service that allows customers to either aggregate multiple Operator Virtual Connections (OVCs) or Ethernet Virtual Connections (EVCs) onto a single External Network to Network Interface (ENNI), or to transparently connect two sites with a single OVC/EVC.

O.A.C. 4901:1-7-14 requires that any change in the ILEC or CLEC carrier to carrier tariff shall be filed as an ATA case and shall be subject to the thirty-day approval procedure set forth in rule 4901:1-6-05 of the Administrative Code.

The Staff has reviewed all documents filed with the application and has determined that the application has satisfied the requirements set forth in the rule. As such, Staff recommends that the application be approved with an effective date of August 28, 2016.
