REVIEW AND RECOMMENDATION SUBMITTED ON BEHALF OF THE STAFF OF THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF OHIO

On August 22, 2016, Cincinnati Bell Any Distance LLC (CBAD) filed an ATA application seeking to revise its Carrier Access Service Tariff P.U.C.O. No. 2. In this application, CBAD proposes to modify its Ohio tariff for the purpose of clarifying that its intrastate terminating switched access rates mirror those of the competing Incumbent Local Exchange Carriers (ILECs), AT&T Ohio and CenturyLink. To accomplish this CBAD proposes to replace the affected rates with a footnote reference to the competing ILECs tariffs in order to comply with the FCC directives regarding the intercarrier compensation reform. The proposed revisions were filed in accordance with the FCC Report and Order and Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (Report and Order) issued on November 18, 2011, in WC Docket Nos. 10-90 et al., FCC No. 11-161, as well as this Commission's Entry on May 4, 2016 in Case No. 10-2387-TP-COI.

Therefore, pursuant to 4901:1-7-14(F) O.A.C. of the Carrier Rules, an application for carrier access tariff amendment must be filed as an ATA subject to the thirty-day automatic approval process The Staff reviewed all documents and exhibits filed with this application and found them to be compliant with Commission rules. Thus, Staff has determined that the proposed revisions to the carrier access tariff appear to satisfy the Commission's requirements set forth in 4901:1-7 of the Administrative Code. Staff recommends that this application be approved with an effective date of September 22, 2016.
