## Iraqi doctors learning ER system in Toledo

TOLEDO - In the war-torn country of Iraq, hospital emer-gency departments are slow to deliver medical care and nurses

deliver medical care and nurses are not empowered to jump in and help patients immediately. Two doctors from a large ac-ademic hospital in Iraq will be training at the University of To-ledo Medical College over the next three weeks. The doctors also spend a portion of each day in the ER at UTMC, the former Medical College of Ohio. Dr. Brickman said. They also will spend time with Dileto area Emergency Medical Service officials learning about how patients are treated and transported to the hospital, he said.

"They don't have that in Iraq either," Dr. Brickman said.
"The whole system is amazing," said Dr. Al Obaidi, referring to the UTMC ER. "I think if it is applied in our country, there's a great jump in the bealth care."

The planning for this collaboration between UT and Kufa University begun several years before Iraq became embroiled in its current military conflict with the terrorist army the Iswith the terrorist group the Is-lamic State in Iraq and Syria, Dr. Brickman said. When ISIS moved in, howev-er, the project came to a halt

about three years ago. After a year of waiting for the situation to improve, Dr. Brickman and the dean of the medical school in Iraq decided to try to move forward with planning the

forward with planning the training.

Each doctor is paying UT about \$10,000 for the ER training, which is just covering the costs, D. B. Brickman said.

Dr. Brickman is planning to take a team of medical professional from UTMC to the Kufa University hospital in Najai next spring. Najai is south of Baghdadi in an area that is not occupied by ISIS, he said.

AEP Ohio Transmission Company Inc. (AEP Ohio Transco) proposes to rebuild a 138-kilovolt (kV) transmission line in Amanda Township in Fairfield County and Harrison Madison and Walnut townships in

The purpose of the Good Hope Harrison 138-kV Transmission Line Rebuild Project is to rebuild an existing 138-kV transmission line within existing right of way. This project will help improve and maintain electric service reliability in south central Ohio. AEP Ohio Transco will build the new line using standard single-pole, steel structures. The overall Good Hope-Harrison transmission line is about 25 miles long. This project will rebuild about half of this line. This project will be an approximate \$15 million investment by AEP Ohio Transco. Construction is scheduled to begin in October 2016.

The project is known as the Good Hope-Harrison 138-kV Transmission Line Rebuild Project, AEP Ohio Transco has filed a Letter of Notification with the Ohio Power Siting Board, under Case No. 16-1487-EL-BLN. This number should be included in all communications with respect to this project. The Letter of Notification to construct, operate and maintain this facility is pending before the board

Petitions to intervene in the Letter of Notification will be accepted by the siting board up to 10 days following the publication date of this notice required by Rule 4906-2-12, Ohio Administrative Code, Petitions should be addressed to Ohio Power Siting Board, 180 East Broad Street. Columbus, Ohio, 43215-3793 and must cite Case No. 16-1487-EL-BLN.


