Dear Sirs:

I am concerned about activities associated with Dayton Power and Light (DP&L) and some of their stated ongoing and/or future planned programs. Of specific concern are:

- DP&L's intention of having the "customer charge," which DP&L was recently forced to reduce back to 2013 (approximate) levels, only to request permission to re-increase those charges in the near future.
 - These anticipated fee increases, apparently, will re-introduce the fees (or charges) but at a level about 300% higher than they are now.
 - It seems that these fees are just designated as a general charge and levied before any other charges are listed. In my view, this is really punishing the people with lower incomes (and therefore required to self-deny themselves of adequate heating during the colder winter months). This seems to be even cruel punishment of those people who are not in a position to do anything about it.
 - It appears that these fees are flat fees levied on all customers equally regardless of how much product is actually used by the customer. This seems to me that by doing this the effect on the low income families is grossly unfair, like the point above.
 - It seems to me that the company should be required to show exactly where those dollars will be used and then be required to reduce those fees as soon as those expenses are satisfied.
- I would like to see DP&L explore reasonable ways to move to renewable energy as
 expediently as possible, along with converting the equipment that does use fossil fuels to
 extremely effective filtration, in order to be able to keep jobs in the parts of Ohio that mine
 coal and pump oil so those people are not devastated like they have been recently. That
 can be done as far as I can see.
