I. SUMMARY

{¶ 1} In this Entry, the Commission approves the tariff filing of Frontier North Inc.

II. DISCUSSION

A. Applicable Law

- {¶ 2} Frontier North Inc. (Frontier) is a public utility defined in R.C. 4905.02 and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission.
- {¶ 3} R.C. 4905.71 authorizes the Commission to determine the reasonable terms, conditions, and charges that a public utility may impose upon a person or entity seeking to attach any wire, cable, facility, or apparatus to a public utility's pole, pedestal, conduit space, or right-of-way.

B. Procedural History

{¶ 4} On July 30, 2014, as revised on October 15, 2014, the Commission, in Case No. 13-579-TP-ORD (Pole Attachment Rules Case), In re the Adoption of Chapter 4901:1-3, Ohio Administrative Code, Concerning Access to Poles, Ducts, Conduits, and Rights-of-Way by Public Utilities, adopted new administrative rules regarding access to poles, ducts, conduits, and rights-of-way of public utilities. The new rules became effective January 8, 2015. On February 25, 2015, as revised on April 22, 2015, the Commission, in the Pole Attachment Rules Case ordered all public utility pole owners in Ohio to file the appropriate

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company-specific tariff amendment application, including the applicable calculations based on 2014 data.

- $\{\P 5\}$ On May 15, 2015, Frontier filed its tariff amendment application in this case.
- {¶ 6} On May 18, 2016, the Commission issued its Finding and Order establishing the rates, terms, and conditions to be incorporated into Windstream Ohio's pole attachment and conduit occupancy tariff. Consistent with the determinations set forth in its Finding and Order, Frontier was directed to file a final tariff on or before June 20, 2016.
- {¶ 7} On June 16, 2016, Frontier filed its revised pole attachment and conduit occupancy tariff.

C. Commission Conclusion

{¶ 8} The Commission finds that the revised pole attachment and conduit occupancy tariff is approved inasmuch as it is consistent with the Commission's May 18, 2016 Finding and Order.

III. ORDER

- {¶ 9} It is, therefore,
- {¶ 10} ORDERED, That the revised pole attachment and conduit occupancy tariff be approved. It is, further,
