- {¶ 1} Ohio Adm.Code Chapter 4901:1-39 provides that the Commission establish a procedural schedule for energy efficiency and peak demand reduction program portfolio plans.
- {¶ 2} Pursuant to discussions with the parties on October 5 and 18, 2016, this matter will be scheduled for hearing on December 1 and 2, 2016, in Hearing Room 11-C. Company testimony will be due November 9, 2016, with intervenor testimony due on November 23, 2016 and Staff testimony on November 25, 2016. The parties will also abide by a ten-day discovery response time.
- [¶ 3] Motions for intervention have been filed by the Ohio Consumers' Counsel (OCC), the Ohio Manufacturers' Association Energy Group (OMAEG), the Kroger Co. (Kroger), the Environmental Law & Policy Center (ELPC), the Industrial Energy Users-Ohio (IEU-Ohio), the Environmental Defense Fund and Ohio Environmental Council (EDF/OEC), People Working Cooperatively (PWC), IGS Energy, Inc. (IGS), the Ohio Hospital Association (OHA), and Ohio Partners for Affordable Energy (OPAE). The motions of OCC, OMAEG, and Kroger were granted by Entry issued on April 7, 2016. The remaining parties have been active participants in energy conservation proceedings, including POR cases, and assert that they have real and substantial interests which may be adversely affected by the outcome of these proceedings, and which cannot be adequately represented by any other party. Further, as no objections

have been filed to the intervention of these parties, the motions for intervention of ELPC, IEU-Ohio, EDF/OEC, PWC, IGS, OHA, and OPAE should be granted.
