Notice of Public Information Meeting for Proposed Wind-Powered Utility Facility

Fred. Olsen Renewables USA LLC/Icebreaker Windpower, Inc. (Lake Erie Energy Development Corporation) (Applicant) has scheduled a Public Information Meeting (open house format) on November 3, 2016 to outline plans to build Icebreaker Wind, a 6-turbine demonstration wind-powered generation facility in Lake Erie, 8-10 miles off the shore of Cleveland, in Cuyahoga County, Ohio. Icebreaker Wind will have a total project generating capacity of 20.7 megawatts and will have an approximately 13-mile long transmission cable that will transmit the electricity to the mainland Cleveland Public Power Lake Road substation.

The purpose of Icebreaker Wind would be to demonstrate the use of offshore wind energy in a freshwater environment. The project would generate renewable power that emits no air or climate pollutants and no mercury. For more information on Icebreaker Wind, see <http://www.leadco.org/icebreaker>.

The Applicant anticipates filing its application with the Ohio Power Siting Board in late 2016. Construction is expected to begin in the spring of 2018, resulting in commercial operations in November 2018.

The Public Information Meeting (open house format) will take place from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. on November 3, 2016 at Lakewood Park Woman's Club Pavilion, 14532 Lake Avenue, Lakewood, Ohio 44107.

The public is invited to attend the meeting. Informational stations will highlight various aspects of the project and company representatives will be available to answer questions and accept comments. Representatives from the Ohio Power Siting Board will also be available to respond to inquiries regarding the state certification process.
