Per the inspector: This gentleman (Phillip Scherer) was hired by the company called Dutch Harness **to take Amish people and their tools** to a job site in Toledo from Indiana. (One of) The Amish man told me he contacts and sets up the truck/driver but the company pays the driver. The trailer was loaded with tools/ladders, no building material. I took them to the job site. The trailer its self was the load along with the 5 passengers in the truck. As for the GVWR I asked the Amish man who said it belonged to him and he told me 12,000. No sticker located on trailer. The questions I asked Mr. Scherer in front of his passengers were accurate, as soon as we got to the job site and the Amish gentleman got out of the truck all the answers changed.

I see 5-10 of these a day coming from Indiana, more in the summer. They are hired by the construction company or by the Amish to get people and tools to the job sites. The trailers always belong to the Amish. Most of them drive 15 passenger vans with no markings.
