

Dear Public Utilities Commission,

I am writing to express my opposition to Dayton Power & Light's plan to raise their fixed-rate residential fee by more than 200% in case number 15-1830-EL-AR. Such a move will affect low-income and low-use customers most heavily, at a time when many in our state have trouble making ends meet. Rather than raise fixed-rate "customer charges" for residential customers, DP&L should be rewarding low-use customers and encouraging energy efficiency. I would be willing to pay more for renewable energy, but it should not fall upon the consumer to subsidize fossil fuels with heavily increased rates.
