It contains a map of Duke's main line pipes and right-of-ways.

It also contains two Safer routes, One using all Duke owned Right of Way I wondered why Duke has not bothered to even mention to the public if they even looked at their eastern Hamilton county main-lines even if to show why they would be unacceptable.
