{¶ 1} Ohio Adm.Code Chapter 4901:1-39 provides that the Commission establish a procedural schedule for energy efficiency and peak demand reduction program portfolio plans.

{¶ 2} By entry issued on December 27, 2016, the hearing of this matter was rescheduled for hearing on February 21, 2017.

{¶ 3} On January 27, 2017, the Company filed an Amended Stipulation which does not include all of the parties.

{¶ 4} On February 1, 2017, a conference call was conducted at the request of the Company, at which time the parties agreed to reschedule the hearing to February 27, 2017, with testimony opposing the Amended Stipulation due February 6, 2017.

{¶ 6} ORDERED, That the hearing of this matter be rescheduled for February 27, 2017, at 10:00 a.m. in Hearing Room 11-D, and the above procedural schedule be observed. It is, further,
