# COMMENTS REGARDING DUKE ENERGY'S APPLICATION TO ADJUST AND SET CHARGES TO CUSTOMERS FOR THE DISTRIBUTION DECOUPLING RIDER BY THE OFFICE OF THE OHIO CONSUMERS' COUNSEL

In Duke Energy Ohio, Inc.'s ("Duke") Application to Adjust and Set Rider DDR ("Application"), Duke seeks to adjust the amount it charges customers under its pilot decoupling mechanism – DDR. The Office of the Ohio Consumers' Counsel ("OCC") takes the filing of the Application as an opportunity to reiterate that charges to customers under the DDR are to end with Duke's pending rate case.<sup>1</sup> The proposed tariff Duke filed with the Application acknowledges that DDR ends with its next distribution rate case.<sup>2</sup> But it does not appear that Duke filed a redline of the DDR tariff in its pending rate case, Case No. 17-0032-EL-AIR et al., that shows the DDR mechanism ending.

OCC appreciates the opportunity to bring this matter to the attention of both Duke and the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio.
