Dear Chairman Haque,

Lyft, Inc. ("Lyft") appreciates the opportunity to comment on the draft rules governing Transportation Network Companies in Ohio. We propose the below minor revisions to section 4901:2-23-06 of the draft rules. We look forward to working with the Ohio Public Utilities Commission in this rulemaking process.

Lyft respectfully proposes to amend the language in section 4901:2-23-06 to read as follows:

Authorized employees of the commission's transportation department may examine any records, documents or property of transportation network companies to the extent necessary in order to assess its compliance with the provisions of sections 4925.03 to 4925.08 of the Revised Code and with the rules adopted under this chapter. Any records disclosed under this section shall be treated as confidential trade secrets and shall not be disclosed to third parties.

This revision would help to protect the privacy of Lyft passengers and drivers from around the country, by adding language to clarify that disclosure is limited to that which is necessary for the Commission to assess Lyft's compliance with regulations governing Transportation Network Companies in Ohio.
