I. SUMMARY

[¶ 1] The Commission finds that this case should be dismissed and closed of record.

- [¶ 2] Staff served a notice of preliminary determination upon James R. Hedges (Respondent), in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-12, alleging violations of the Commission's transportation safety regulations.
- {¶ 3} On January 9, 2017, Respondent filed a request for an administrative hearing in the above-captioned case in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-13.
- {¶ 4} A prehearing teleconference was convened in this matter on January 26, 2017. Subsequently, a hearing was scheduled on February 22, 2017.
- {¶ 5} On February 21, 2017, Staff filed a notice of dismissal in the case. In the notice, Staff stated that all of the violations and forfeitures against Respondent relevant to the above-captioned case before the Commission have been dropped. Further, Staff stated that a hearing is no longer necessary.
- {¶ 6} On February 21, 2017, the scheduled February 22, 2017 hearing was canceled pending Commission action on Staff's notice of dismissal.
- {¶ 7} In view of Staff's notice of dismissal, this case should be dismissed and closed of record.
