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EXAMINER FULLIN: The Commission has assigned for hearing at this time and place Case No. 14-2313-EL-CSS which is the Complaint of Janice L. Guess versus American Electric Power.

My name is Daniel E. Fullin, the Attorney Examiner assigned to this case. May I have appearances on behalf of the parties beginning with the Complainant which means I am asking you to identify your name and address for the record.

MR. BENZA: Your Honor, Mike Benza on behalf of Respondent Ohio Power Company doing business as AEP Ohio named in the complaint as American Electric Power Company. Complainant Janice L. Guess is not present here today.

EXAMINER FULLIN: Oh, okay. I thought the mediating Attorney Examiner had been in touch with Ms. Guess and had indicated I might expect that she wasn't going to be here today. So I guess we can wait about 10 minutes before we find out if she is coming even though based on that I am not necessarily expecting her.

And then at that point if she doesn't

show within the next 10 minutes, then I would bring the hearing to a close based on the fact she didn't appear.

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Let's go off the record for a minute.

(Discussion off the record.)

EXAMINER FULLIN: Let's go back on the record.

We are back on the record. Mr. Benza has indicated he has heard from the Complainant as early as Monday of this week, this is Thursday, that the Complainant had informed him that the -- that she wasn't going to be in attendance today.

Also, I don't know if I said this earlier on the record or not, but the mediating Attorney Examiner has been in discussions with the Complainant, and he had told -- she had told him that she wasn't expecting to be here today.

So based on both of those -- based on that information and the fact she isn't here, I am not going to wait to see if she shows up in the next few minutes. I am going to go ahead and allow the Respondent to make a motion at this time.

MR. BENZA: Thank you, your Honor. AEP
Ohio would like to move to dismiss for failure to
prosecute. I can make this motion in writing and

file it in the docket by tomorrow afternoon, Friday, March 10, 2017, by 5 p.m., or if your Honor would prefer, or if your Honor is satisfied, we can submit this motion as we have on the record here today.

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EXAMINER FULLIN: Well, I would be okay with just ruling on it as an oral motion made at the hearing. If there was something — if you put it in writing or there was something more you would add that you didn't just say, then you can do it that way, and I am not going to be ruling on it before tomorrow afternoon anyway.

So I will leave it to you if you want to make a written motion but there's already a motion before me that's based on the fact she's not here, and she is not here, so I would be -- you wouldn't necessarily have to make such a filing. I intend to rule based on the oral motion and/or motion if you submit one tomorrow.

MR. BENZA: Okay. Thank you, your Honor. We are satisfied with our oral motion.

EXAMINER FULLIN: Okay. I am too, so I am going to bring this hearing to a close at this time, and we will be adjourned.

(Thereupon, at 10:00 a.m., the hearing was concluded.)
