NOTICE OF INTERVENTION

BY RON HIRTH ON BEHALF OF THE VILLAGE OF GOLF MANOR, OHIO

Now comes Mayor Ron Hirth ("Mayor Hirth"), Mayor for the Village of Golf

Manor, Hamilton County, Ohio ("Golf Manor"), and files this Notice of Intervention in

the above captioned case pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 4906.08(A) and Ohio

Administrative Code (O.A.C.) Rule 4906-2-12(A)(1). O.A.C. 4906-2-12(A)(1) provides:

The chief executive officer of each municipal corporation and county and the head of each public agency charged with the duty of protecting the environment or of planning land use in the area in which any portion of such facility is to be located may intervene by preparing and filing with the board, within thirty days after the date he or she was served with a copy of the application under division (B) of section 4906.06 of the Revised Code, a notice of intervention containing the following information:

(a) A certification or affirmation as to the legal title and authority of such official.

(b) A statement demonstrating the fact that all or part of the proposed facility is to be located within the area under the jurisdiction of such official.

(c) A statement indicating that such official intends to intervene in the proceedings, together with the grounds for which intervention is sought. As set forth in the attached Affidavit of Ron Hirth, Ron Hirth holds the legal title and authority of Mayor of the Village of Golf Manor, Hamilton County, Ohio, and he serves as the official head of the Village.

With respect to O.A.C. 4906-2-12(A)(1)(b), portions of the proposed alternate route of the Central Corridor Pipeline Extension Project ("Project") are to be situated within Golf Manor. The proposed alternate pipeline route passes through and adjacent to the remaining commercial corridor within Golf Manor, which is the foundation for the economic survival of the Village of Golf Manor. Additionally, as a compact residential community of less than one square mile, the Project's location is too closely aligned with the only remaining recreational facilities within the Village and the perimeter of its residential land.

Golf Manor anticipates that through its Intervention it may act with other jurisdictions to represent regional interest common to the Village of Golf Manor and other political subdivisions, including an evaluation of the Project need and related safety issues.

Finally, Ron Hirth, on behalf of Golf Manor, Ohio, intends to intervene in this proceeding, and the basis for such intervention is that the Project has proved to be a matter of public importance to Golf Manor citizens, businesses, infrastructure and public institutions. In the alternative, this Notice of Intervention should also be considered as a Motion to Intervene based on the above stated reasons. The Project raises substantial environmental, logistical, and operational issues in which Golf Manor wants to participate, and the Project will impact Golf Manor's residents, businesses, infrastructure,

and public institutions as described above. Golf Manor has a paramount interest in protecting the health and welfare and land planning of its citizens.
