DNE submitted 2015 annual reports, but due to administrative oversight, did not pay the required \$100 annual assessment on time. This resulted in the assessment being referred to the Ohio Attorney General for collections. DNE remitted the assemment to the Ohio Attorney General In December 2016. However, DNE remained subject to the September 14, 2016 Order in Case No. 15-01-AU-RPT, which revoked the certificates of companies that had not paid their 2015 assessments by that date, which included DNE.

DNE became aware of the certicate revocation in the course of preparing to renew Certificate Nos. 13-305(G) and 13-694(E). DNE regrets this oversight, and has instituted measures to prevent such oversight in the future..






