{¶ 1} TeleDias Communications, Inc. (TeleDias), currently holds Certificate No. 90-6091, issued by the Commission in Case No. 02-2483-CT-ACE, under which it is authorized to provide competitive telecommunication services throughout the state of Ohio, pursuant to its tariff.

{¶ 2} On January 24, 2017, TeleDias filed an application seeking to abandon its operating authority under Certificate 90-6091.

{¶ 3} Pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-6-06(C), TeleDias' abandonment application was suspended for 60 days by attorney examiner's entry issued February 23, 2017, so that additional information could be submitted and additional investigation could be done on the application.

{¶ 4} Additional information and investigation is still necessary in order to complete a review of TeleDias' abandonment application. Therefore, in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-6-06(C), this matter is being suspended from the automatic process and cannot now be approved without a Commission order.

{¶ 5} It is, therefore,

{¶ 6} ORDERED, That the application in this case be suspended from the automatic approval process in accordance with Finding (2). It is, further,

{¶ 7} ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon TeleDias and all interested persons of record.
