

Background

On May 10, 2017, The Dayton Power and Light Company filed its proposed tariffs to modify its Standard Offer generation tariffs. The proposed tariffs include Standard Service Offer (SSO) generation rates and Percentage of Income Payment Plan (PIPP) generation rates.

The proposed SSO rates include the results of the most recent auctions held April 11, 2017 and April 24, 2017, and approved by the Commission on April 12, 2017 and April 26, 2017, respectively, in Case No. 17-957-EL-UNC. The proposed PIPP generation rates reflect the results of the PIPP auction held May 1, 2017 and approved by the Commission on May 3, 2017 in Case No. 17-1163-EL-UNC.

The Company requests that the proposed tariffs become effective on June 1, 2017.

Staff Review and Recommendations

Staff has reviewed the proposed tariffs filed on May 10, 2017, and finds that the tariffs appear to be in compliance with Commission Orders and accurately reflect the April 11, 2017, April 24, 2017 and May 1, 2017, auction results.

Conclusion

The Staff recommends that the proposed tariffs filed on May 10, 2017, be approved and become effective June 1, 2017.
