{¶ 1} A settlement conference was convened in this case on April 27, 2017. After the conference, the parties in the case indicated that a tentative settlement agreement had been reached and that paperwork documenting the agreement would be submitted to the Commission in the near future.

{¶ 2} When contacted by the attorney examiner, counsel for the Respondent, The Dayton Power and Light Company (DP&L), stated that settlement documents had been mailed to Brenda Jennings (Complainant), but had not been returned to DP&L. A subsequent voicemail was left by the attorney examiner at the Complainant's telephone number, but she has not returned the call.

{¶ 3} This case shall proceed utilizing one of two options: The Complainant may (a) file a letter, by June 30, 2017, requesting either dismissal or continued action on the complaint, or (b) take no action with regard to the complaint by the close of business on June 30, 2017, and the attorney examiner will recommend to the Commission that this case be dismissed.
