{¶ 1} A telephonic prehearing conference was convened in this case on June 20, 2017; however, Staff was unable to contact Gary Johansen (the Respondent) at that time. Subsequently, a hearing date of July 18, 2017, was established.

{¶ 2} Accordingly, this case should now be scheduled for hearing on July 18, 2017, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission, in Hearing Room 11-C, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215-3793.

{¶ 3} Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-14(E) provides that a respondent who has requested an administrative hearing and fails to participate in the hearing proceeding shall be in default. The rule additionally states that a respondent in default shall be deemed to have admitted the occurrence of the violation and waived all further right to contest liability to the state for the forfeiture described in the notice.

{¶ 4} Following Staff's presentation of evidence at the hearing, it shall be the responsibility of the Respondent to present evidence in support of his contentions regarding the alleged violations in this matter.

{¶ 5} It is, therefore,

{¶ 6} ORDERED, That Case No. 17-1158-TR-CVF be scheduled for hearing in accordance with paragraph (2). It is, further,

{¶ 7} ORDERED, That all findings herein be observed by the parties in this case. It is, further,

{¶ 8} ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon each party of record.
