the extent applicable, are required to file with the Federal Communications Commission

(FCC) a report by July 3, 2017, pertaining to the information required pursuant to this section.

This report must be filed in order for an ETC to continue to receive low-income support for

the following calendar year or to retain its ETC designation.

{¶ 2} ETCs should informally submit a copy of their FCC responses to the

Commission Staff. The responses should be electronically submitted to the following secure

email address: Ohio-FCCForms481@puco.ohio.gov. An ETC that has already filed a copy of

its FCC responses pursuant to the Entry of May 22, 2017, in Case No. 17-1115-TP-COI, does

not need to file another copy of its responses.
