I. SUMMARY

{¶ 1} The Commission grants the parties' joint motion to dismiss this complaint case with prejudice, on grounds that the parties have reached a settlement resolving all issues raised.

II. DISCUSSION

{¶ 2} Pursuant to R.C. 4927.21, the Commission has authority to consider written complaints filed against a telephone company by any person or corporation regarding any rate, service, regulation, or practice relating to any service furnished by the telephone company that is in any respect unjust, unreasonable, insufficient, or unjustly discriminatory.

{¶ 3} Respondent, The Ohio Bell Telephone Company d/b/a AT&T Ohio (AT&T Ohio), is a telephone company as defined in R.C. 4905.03 and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.

{¶ 4} On January 19, 2017, Superior Credit Union filed a complaint against AT&T Ohio alleging a billing dispute exists between the parties.

{¶ 5} On February 8, 2017, AT&T Ohio filed its answer, in which it admits some and denies others of the allegations of the complaint and sets forth several affirmative defenses.

{¶ 6} A settlement conference was scheduled for, and held, on March 27, 2017. A tentative settlement was reportedly arrived at between the parties at that time.

{¶ 7} On May 5, 2017, the parties jointly filed a motion to dismiss this case with prejudice, on grounds that it has been settled.

{¶ 8} Accordingly, the Commission finds the parties' joint motion should be granted and this case should be dismissed with prejudice.


III. ORDER

{¶ 11} ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon each party of record.






