I. SUMMARY

{¶ 1} The Commission grants the joint motion to dismiss the complaint with prejudice as the parties represent that all issues and claims have been resolved.

II. DISCUSSION

{¶ 2} Pursuant to R.C. 4905.26, the Commission has authority to consider written complaints filed against a public utility by any person or corporation regarding any rate, service, regulation, or practice relating to any service furnished by the public utility that is in any respect unjust, unreasonable, insufficient, or unjustly discriminatory.

{¶ 3} Respondent, The Dayton Power and Light Company (DP&L or Company), is a public utility as defined in R.C. 4905.02 and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.

{¶ 4} On January 26, 2017, Brenda Jennings (Complainant) filed a complaint against DP&L alleging that DP&L improperly terminated her electric service.

{¶ 5} DP&L filed its answer on February 15, 2017. In its answer, DP&L admitted some and denied other allegations in the complaint. In addition, DP&L set forth in the answer several affirmative defenses.

{¶ 6} On June 21, 2017, Complainant and DP&L filed a joint motion to dismiss. In the motion, the parties advise the Commission that they have entered into a full and comprehensive settlement agreement regarding the complaint. Further, having resolved all issues and claims arising in conjunction with the matters set forth in this proceeding, the parties request that this complaint be dismissed with prejudice.

{¶ 7} In view of the settlement of the complaint, the Commission finds that this case should be dismissed and closed of record.


### III. ORDER






