





Like many concerned, educated consumers in Ohio, we have learned how to be thoughtful about our energy consumption, in part, because *our utilities taught us to do this to conserve our resources*.

We use a programmable thermostat, we turn off lights, we upgraded lighting and bulbs, we have upgraded our windows, doors and insulation, we power off/unplug many items to avoid as much trickle as possible. We have upgraded our appliances and fixtures to reduce power consumption as well.

As a result, we have been able to reduce our electric, gas and water bills to manageable amounts. THIS DOES NOT MEAN OUR BUDGET IS ABLE TO HANDLE ANY INCREASES, SUCH AS THOSE PROPOSED IN CASE #17-0334-EL-ATA.

We traded our huge energy bills in exchange for our substantial investment in smarter energy use (why? because it was the right thing to do.). By my calculation, we still have about ten (10) years before our current investments show returns... Even then we will still be behind because we will have to replace at least one appliance, the refrigerator, and our air conditioning unit is old as is our water tank. That will add another 10 years waiting for our return on our investment.**

{Energy efficient replacements still cost significantly more than those produced using older technology. The *upcharge* on energy efficient refrigerators, water tanks and air conditioning systems is <u>huge</u>, about **triple what non-efficient units cost versus the most efficient units. 

I recently became aware of a First Energy application to **triple** a "customer charge" previously granted by PUCO from \$6-\$8 per month to \$18-\$25 per month.

My wife and I are in our 60's and the promise of retirement seems to be fading from our possibilities. Our income has never risen by 300% in our lives. To allow a corporation to impose this unfair tax on citizens regardless of their electric usage and life circumstances seems contrary to the purpose of PUCO to look out for the interests of Ohio citizens.

It seems that in response to a paltry 2-4% increases in income, if any, our public officials and corporations like First Energy continually conspire to seek money grabs that in effect result in **lower** real income, provides less discretionary spending, less ability to save and purchase energy efficient appliances, tools, and energy saving upgrades to our home.

I urge PUCO to challenge the scope of this rate increase. To require full disclosure on our bills for what the increase pays for and how much is for return to stockholders and executive salaries. What is the rate for business to business customers, which in my experience favors the corporations at the expense of residential customers?

I wish you well in your endeavors and appreciate the opportunity to comment. Your actions will determine if public comment is of any value.




