In addition to being licensed in Ohio, Emuna Energy, LLC is currently licensed as a Public Utility - Agents, Brokers and Consultants ("ABC") in the state of Illinois.

#### EXHIBIT B-2 "Experience & Plans"

Emuna Energy, LLC is a recognized channel partner of Energy Market Exchange and Duke Energy and will act as the non-exclusive agent of business customers to price out the customer's electricity usage. Emuna Energy also seeks to become channel partners with other certified electric generators so that the customer has numerous pricing proposals to consider. All billing is done by the certified electric generator, as with all collection. In some limited circumstances, Emuna Energy will be the exclusive agent of the business customer for purposes of pricing their electricity usage. Contracts with other customers will delineate whether Emuna Energy is their exclusive agent or whether it is acting on a non-exclusive basis. Emuna Energy will respond to any customer inquiries or complaints in accordance with the Commission's rules.

### EXHIBIT B-3 "Summary of Experience"

At Emuna Energy we employ both energy consultants and energy engineers who are capable of determining both the best energy consumption products and practices while they build a custom portfolio of supplier relationship that result in lower per unit energy costs. 
