SUMMARY

On July 31, 2017, Ohio Gas Company (Ohio Gas) filed an application (Application) seeking approval of a special contract for interruptible transportation service with Gerald Grain Center, located in Delta, Ohio. On August 7, 2017, Ohio Gas amended its Application.

The special contract includes a customer charge, declining block transportation rates, record keeping charge, unaccounted for gas rate, balancing fees and imbalance provisions. The initial term of the agreement is one year and continues thereafter as a month-to-month agreement subject to a 30-day cancellation notice by either party.
