

On 06/15/2017, a vehicle operated by CASSENS TRANSPORT COMPANY, and driven by THOMAS J NATHO, was inspected within the State of Ohio. As the result of discovery of the following violations of the Commission's rules, Staff of the Commission timely notified THOMAS J NATHO (Respondent) pursuant to rule 4901:2-7-07, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), that it intended to assess a civil forfeiture against the Respondent in the following amount:
