{¶ 1} Pursuant to R.C. 4905.31 and Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-38-05(A), an electric utility may file an application for Commission approval of a unique arrangement with one or more of the electric utility's customers.

{¶ 2} On August 23, 2017, The Dayton Power and Light Company (DP&L) filed a joint application for an extension of a unique arrangement with Wright-Patterson Air Force Base (WPAFB), to ensure that economic conditions which encourage job growth and retention exist at WPAFB, by providing reliable, safe electric service at a reasonable and predictable rate. The Commission previously approved the original application on October 22, 2014, which is set to expire on December 31, 2017.

{¶ 3} The attorney examiner finds that a hearing should be held in order to consider the extension of the application for a unique arrangement. Accordingly, this matter should be set for hearing on October 10, 2017, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, 11th Floor, Hearing Room 11-D, Columbus, Ohio 43215-3793.

{¶ 4} It is, therefore,

{¶ 5} ORDERED, That a hearing in this matter be held in accordance with Paragraph (3). It is, further,

{¶ 6} ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.
