I. SUMMARY

{¶ 1} The Commission finds that the September 27, 2017 Finding and Order should be amended nunc pro tunc.

II. APPLICABLE LAW

{¶ 2} R.C. 4923.99 provides for the Commission to assess civil forfeitures for violations of R.C. Chapters 4921 and 4923, and rules adopted thereunder. R.C. 4921.21(B)(2) provides that the first \$800,000 in civil forfeitures collected under R.C. 4923.99 for violations of rules applicable to the highway transportation of hazardous materials shall be credited to the public utilities transportation safety fund. The Commission is tasked with distributing the moneys to “educational institutions, state agencies, regional planning commissions, and political subdivisions” for the purposes of “emergency response planning and the training of safety, enforcement, and emergency services personnel in proper techniques for the management of hazardous materials releases that occur during transportation or otherwise.” R.C. 4921.21(B)(2). This section also sets forth the manner in which such funds shall be distributed by the Commission for the purposes of emergency response planning.

{¶ 3} On September 27, 2017, the Commission issued a Finding and Order awarding hazardous materials training grants to twelve applicants totaling \$221,485.21. The training grants were awarded on a reimbursement basis to the selected applicants and the specific allocations were outlined in an Attachment to the Finding and Order.

{¶ 4} However, the Attachment incorrectly stated on page 3 that "The City of Toledo, Department of Public Utilities, Division of Environmental Services is awarded \$9,553.50." Instead, the sentence should read "The City of Toledo, Department of Public Utilities, Division of Environmental Services is awarded \$22,693.00."

III. ORDER

{¶ 5} It is, therefore,


{¶ 6} ORDERED, That the September 27, 2017 Finding and Order be amended nunc pro tunc. It is, further,

{¶ 7} ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.


