{¶ 1} Pursuant to R.C. 4905.26, the Commission has authority to consider written complaints filed against a public utility by any person or corporation regarding any rate, service, regulation, or practice relating to any service furnished by the public utility that is in any respect unjust, unreasonable, insufficient, or unjustly discriminatory.

{¶ 2} By Entry issued September 11, 2017, the Complainant, Cynthia Wingo, was directed to file an amended complaint within ten days, and Nationwide Energy Partners, LLC (NEP) was directed to file any amendments to its answer and motion to dismiss within ten days of the filing of the amended complaint.

{¶ 3} The Complainant file an amended complaint on September 19, 2017, and NEP filed an amended motion to dismiss the complaint for lack of jurisdiction on September 29, 2017. The Complainant then filed a memorandum contra NEP's motion on October 10, 2017.

{¶ 4} On October 11, 2017, NEP filed a motion to extend the due date for the filing of its reply to the Complainant's memorandum contra until October 24, 2017, and requesting an expedited ruling on such motion pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901-1-12(C) and 4901-1-13. In support of its motion, NEP states that all counsel of record for other

parties have been notified of this request, and none objects to either the requested seven-day extension or the issuance of an expedited ruling on its motion.

{¶ 5} As opposing counsel do not oppose the requested extension, NEP's motion is granted and NEP is directed to file its reply to the Complainant's memorandum contra by October 24, 2017.

{¶ 6} It is, therefore,

{¶ 7} ORDERED, That NEP file its reply to the Complainant's memorandum contra by October 24, 2017. It is, further,

{¶ 8} ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon each party of record.
