- A. Yes. DP&L believes that the Wright-Patterson unique arrangement is reasonable, cost effective, and promotes state policy. Customers and residents in the Dayton region benefit from over 28,000 jobs currently at the base and indirect jobs supporting base missions. The region will benefit from the retention and potential new jobs that are coming to the base. The State of Ohio benefits from the job retention, job growth, and tax bases this unique arrangement DP&L provides. DP&L respectfully requests the Commission to approve the unique

arrangement as filed and find the total cost of the unique arrangement is covered -- recovered through the company's economic development rider.
