AEP: 16-1852-EL-SSO DP&L: 15-1830-EL-AIR Duke Energy: 17-0032-EL-AIR FirstEnergy: 17-0334-EL-ATA A increase in the fixed rate will disproportionately affect low income people -- and worse there would be nothing they could do about it (such as change their thermostat).
