Project Construction Plan

In the Report of Investigation filed on October 26, 2017 in the above captioned case, the Ohio Power Siting Board Staff requested that NGO Transmission, Inc. ("NGOT") submit to Staff, prior to construction, a project construction plan which includes the specific locations of its laydown areas.

NGOT does not intend to use laydown areas for the construction of the project. NGOT's gas operations field office is located at 120 O'Neill Dr. in Hebron, Ohio, approximately 2.5 miles from the project location. As a result, pipeline and associated materials will be stored at NGOT's field office and transported to the project location as needed during construction.

Construction equipment, including trackhoes, boring machines, construction trailers, and other miscellaneous equipment, will be stored within the gated area of NGOT's West Check regulator station at the northern end of the project (which is located on property owned by NGOT). During construction, NGOT intends to stage pipeline and related materials within the easement and right of way areas and any additional construction widths provided for in the pipeline easements. No staging of pipeline and materials will occur within emerging wetlands areas.

Because NGOT does not intend to use laydown areas and will store construction equipment on property owned by NGOT, NGOT does not anticipate any additional impacts to the project area. This foregoing document was electronically filed with the Public Utilities
