# Elliott gets temporary restraining order

Dallas Cowboys running back Ezekiel Elliott is eligible to play again as a New York judge granted his motion for a temporary restraining order blocking the six-game suspension for violating the NFLs personal conduct policy. It means that Elliott will be

back at practice Wednesday and be on the field when the team resumes play Sunday against the San Francisco 49ers after last week's bye.

The ruling is temporary and will last for up to 14 days. Elliott and his lawyers from the NFL Players Association will have to again plead their case to Judge Katherine Failla when she is back from vaca-

The decision was made by U.S. District Judge Paul Crotty, who was filling in for Failla.

Failla will ultimately decide if Elliott gets a preliminary injunction, similar to what he got from Judge Amos Mazzant of the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Texas.

AEP Ohio Transmission Company Inc., (AEF Ohio Transco), an affiliate of AEP Ohio, proposes to construct an approximate 1-mile 138-kilovolt (kV) transmission line in Trimble Township in Athens County. The project is known as the Trimble 138 kV Extension Project. This project will be an approximate \$6 million investment by AEP Ohio Transco. Construction is scheduled to begin in early 2018.

The purpose of the project is to improve electric service reliability and reduce outages. New right-of-way acquisition is planned to accommodate steel, single note structures approximately 110-feet in height.
