NOTICE OF PROPOSED MAJOR UTILITY FACILITY

AEP Ohio and its affiliate, AEP Ohio Transmission Company Inc. (AEP Ohio Transco), propose to rebuild a 138 kilovolt (kV) electric transmission line in Washington County.

The project is known as the Macksburg-Devola 138 kV Transmission Line Rebuild Project. AEP Ohlo Transco filed its application with the Ohlo Power Siting Board (OPSB), under Case No. 16-0702-EL-BTX. This number should be included in all communications with respect to this project. The application to construct, operate and maintain this facility is pending before the board.

NOVEMBER 1, 2017, 6:00 P.M. LOWER SALEM FLEMENTARY SCHOOL

The public hearing in this case shall consist of two parts:

(a) A local public hearing is scheduled to begin at δ p.m., Wednesday, November 1, 2017, at Lower Salem Elementary School, 10930 OH-821, Lower Salem, Ohio 45745. At this local public hearing on November 1, the public will be given an opportunity to comment on this project to the OPSB. AEP Ohio and AEP Ohio Transco invite all residents and property owners who wish to present written or oral testimony, to attend this public hearing; and

(b) An adjudicatory hearing commencing at 10 a.m., Thursday, November 16, 2017, 11th Floor, Hearing Room 11-0, at the offices of the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio, 43215-3793. The hearing on November 16, at the PUCO offices, is open to the public, but participation is limited to the parties in the case.

The proposed Macksburg-Devola transmission line is part of the overall Southeast Ohio Area Improvements. The project will improve service for customers, cut down on power outages and speed service restoration when outages occur.

The Macksburg-Devola transmission line will be a 138 kV transmission line that connects the Macksburg Substation to the new Devola Substation in

The Macksburg-Devola line will be approximately 17 miles long, depending on the route selected. The line will likely run through Adams, Aurelius, Marietta Muskingum and Salem townships in Washington County.
