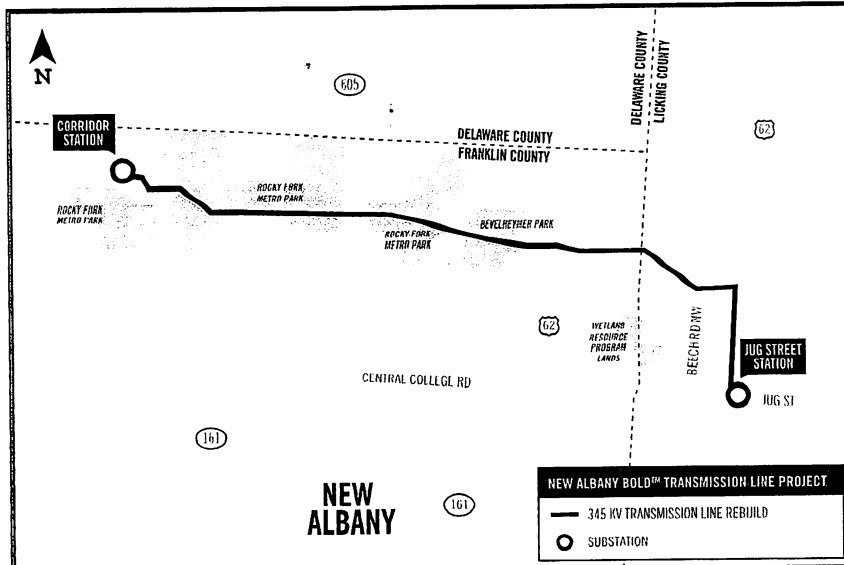

This project includes plans to replace about 6.5 miles of 345 kV transmission facilities with new 345 and 138 kV transmission facilities. During the project, which will last about a year, existing wooden structures will be replaced with BOLD structures. BOLD - Breakthrough Overhead Line Design - was developed by local engineers and delivers a more efficient line design with a contemporary look, has a smaller footprint and shorter structure height. This technology will be a first for the state of Ohio.

This project strengthens and improves the transmission system to meet the region's growing demand for electricity - now and into the future. This project will be an approximate \$30 million investment by AEP Ohio Transco. Construction is scheduled to begin in early 2018.

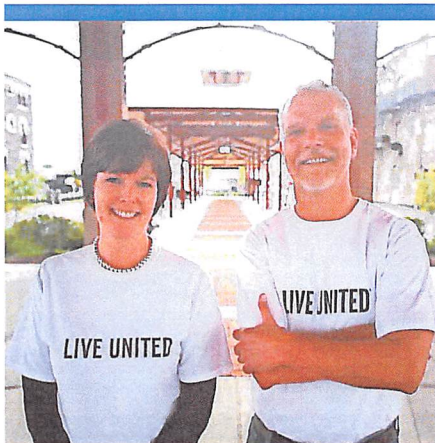

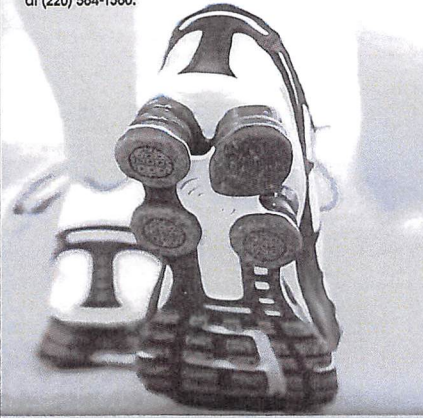

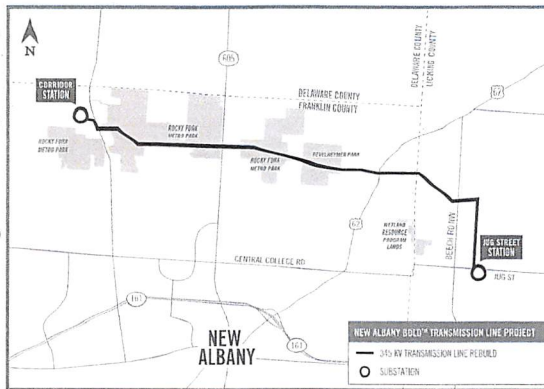
