- {¶ 1} Duke Energy Ohio, Inc. (Duke) is an electric light company and public utility as defined by R.C. 4905.03(C) and R.C. 4905.02, respectively. As such, Duke is subject to the Commission's jurisdiction pursuant to R.C. 4905.04, 4905.05, and 4905.06.
- {¶ 2} On March 2, 2017, Duke filed applications for an increase in electric distribution rates, for approval of tariff modifications, and for approval of changes in certain accounting methods.
- {¶ 3} Staff conducted an investigation and filed its report on September 26, 2017. A supplement to the report was filed on October 12, 2017.
- {¶ 4} By Entry issued September 28, 2017, the attorney examiner issued a procedural schedule. The procedural schedule was amended by Entry on October 18, 2017. Among other things, the Entry scheduled an evidentiary hearing for December 11, 2017. Subsequently, on November 3, 2017, the attorney examiner granted Staff's motion for an extension of the procedural schedule. Specifically, testimony on behalf of intervenors was to be filed by November 15, 2017.
- $\{\P 5\}$ On November 9, 2017, Staff filed a motion requesting a continuance of the procedural schedule. Specifically, Staff requests that the date for all pre-filed testimony be

extended until November 29, 2017, and the date of the evidentiary hearing be extended until

January 3, 2018. Staff maintains that settlement discussions are ongoing and the parties would

benefit from additional time. According to Staff, the motion is unopposed.

 $\{\P 6\}$ The attorney examiner finds good cause exists to grant Staff's motion.

Accordingly, all pre-filed testimony for Duke and intervenors should be filed by November 29,

2017, and the evidentiary hearing should begin on January 3, 2018. Rebuttal testimony will be

scheduled at the conclusion of the hearing.

{¶ 8} ORDERED, That Staff's motion for an extension of the procedural schedule be

granted. It is, further,

¶ 9} ORDERED, That the procedural schedule be extended in accordance with

Paragraph 6. It is, further,
