I. SUMMARY

{¶ 1} The Commission accepts the waiver of the parties for any further hearing in this matter.

II. DISCUSSION

{¶ 2} On January 18, 2017, the Commission issued its Opinion and Order adopting the December 9, 2016 Stipulation, which under ¶IV.X, provided for a hearing on the continuation of the annual cost cap on the recovery of energy efficiency and peak demand reduction program costs and shared savings.

{¶ 3} By Entry issued on September 28, 2017, a hearing was scheduled for October 23, 2017, but subsequently continued at the request of the Environmental Law & Policy Center, Natural Resources Defense Council, Ohio Environmental Council, and Environmental Defense Fund (collectively, Environmental Intervenors).

{¶ 4} On November 3, 2017, Staff filed correspondence requesting that the hearing be cancelled as the Environmental Intervenors have agreed to waive their rights to a hearing under ¶IV.X of the December 9, 2016 Stipulation. Further, Staff indicates that none of the other parties oppose such waiver and the cancellation of the hearing.

{¶ 5} Pursuant to agreement of the parties, the hearing under ¶IV.X of the December 9, 2016 Stipulation will be cancelled.

{¶ 6} It is, therefore,

{¶ 7} ORDERED, That the hearing under ¶IV.X of the December 9, 2016 Stipulation be cancelled. It is, further,

{¶ 8} ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.
