MR. ARNOLD: Yes, Your Honor. My name is Dale Arnold, and I am Director of Energy, Utility and Local Government Policy with Ohio Farm Bureau.

We have a motion to intervene, party of first record in the case. I am here just to observe this evening. Thank you.

ALJ JENNINGS: Thank you. The subject of today's hearing is Hardin Solar Energy's application to construct a solar-powered electric generation facility in Marion, Roundhead and McDonald Townships in Hardin County, Ohio.

The project will consist of numerous ground mounted solar panels on over 1,000 acres of land. It also includes a battery storage facility. The panels will have a capacity to generate up to 150 megawatts of electricity.

The Power Siting Board Staff filed a report in this case on November 21th, 2017.

After conducting an investigation and review the Staff gave a recommendation to allow Hardin Solar Energy to proceed with the project subject to several conditions.

Staff's report serves as a recommendation to the Board, but the Board still has the final decision. An evidentiary hearing is scheduled for December 15, 2017. That will be at the offices of the Ohio Power Siting Board in Columbus, Ohio.

Hardin Solar Energy's application and the Staff report are available for review on the Power Siting website under the case number of this case.

The purpose of this hearing is to receive comments from the public regarding the application in this case. I will emphasize that this is not a question and answer session. It is your opportunity to let the Power Siting Board know what you think about the proposal. There are representatives of Hardin Solar Energy, who have been pointed out, who are available for questions after the hearing. Power Siting's Staff is here as well.

There is a court reporter who will

transcript all statements. The transcript will become part of the record in this case, and it too will be made available for public viewing.
