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

Chrislynn Energy Services, Inc. provides consulting services to commercial, industrial and governmental mercantile customers pursuant to section 4929.01 of the Ohio Revised Code. Chrislynn Energy Services, Inc.'s services include: review of tariffs and rates; review of utility bills; identifying alternative energy suppliers and services; procuring price quotes from energy suppliers for client review and consideration; and providing advice to clients regarding their energy purchases. Terms and conditions from PUCO Certificated CRNGS suppliers will be presented to clients and agreements will be executed directly between clients and suppliers.

Chrislynn Energy Services, Inc. will not be billing customers directly for its consulting services or paying customer bills in its consultant role. Customers will continue to pay their bills directly to the distribution utility or CRNGS suppliers, as appropriate. Chrislynn Energy Services, Inc. will be compensated for its services through a "price adder," which is added to the customer's Utility bill or Natural Gas supplier bill, as appropriate. Revenues collected against the price adder will be remitted by the CRNGS supplier to Chrislynn Energy Services, Inc. or from Utility through the CRNGS supplier to Chrislynn Energy Services, Inc.

Chrislynn Energy Services, Inc. will timely respond to customer inquiries and complaints in accordance with the Commission's rules by presenting an apples to apples comparison of supplier offers and terms and conditions. Chrislynn Energy Services, Inc. will educate customers on all components of suppliers' offers and agreements that are applicable to Ohio Revised Code Section 4929.22. If an inquiry or complaint arises, Chrislynn Energy Services, Inc. will promptly work with the customer and the chosen CRNGS supplier to resolve the issue by reference to the detailed pricing offer and section of the CRNGS supplier terms and conditions that addresses the inquiry or complaint. All responses and attempts to resolve the inquiry or complaint will be provided in writing for proper documentation and to ensure that a clear resolution and/or understanding of the matter is provided to the customer.
