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MEMORANDUM

Pursuant to Rules 4901-1-12 and 4901:1-14-02, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), Duke Energy Ohio, Inc., (Duke Energy Ohio or the Company) respectfully requests a waiver of O.A.C. 4901:1-14-08(C), as well as the Commission Entry issued in conjunction therewith. This rule requires a natural gas utility such as Duke Energy Ohio to publish notice of a gas cost recovery audit hearing between 15 and 30 days prior to the date set for its hearing. Specifically, O.A.C. 4901:1-14-08(C) provides that:

The gas or natural gas company shall publish notice of the hearing required under paragraph (A) of this rule throughout its service area at least fifteen and not more than thirty days prior to the scheduled date of hearing by:

- (1) Display ad in a newspaper or newspapers of general circulation;
- (2) Bill message on or bill insert included with the customer bills; or
- (3) Separate direct mailing to customers.²

The Commission's Entry establishing the procedural schedule for these cases required the Company to publish the notice described in O.A.C. 4901:1-14-08(C) and to do so in a section of the newspaper other than the legal notices section.³

Duke Energy Ohio requested that the newspapers in its service area publish the legal notice within the stated time frame and in a general news section. Unfortunately, one of the newspapers did publish in a timely manner but in the legal classified section, not the general news section. The legal notice is being re-published on either January 25 or 26, 2017, in the general news section. However, this re-publication will not be timely for January 30, 2017, hearing.

For the reasons stated above, Duke Energy Ohio respectfully requests a waiver of a portion of the rule and Entry⁴ that, taken together, require publication at least 15 days prior to the hearing, in a newspaper section other than the legal notices section.
