THE ATTORNEY EXAMINER: The Public
Utilities Commission of Ohio of Ohio has called for
hearing at this time and place Case No.
17-450-TR-CVF being in the matter of Anthony K.
Culver and Ricky M. Savoie, notice of apparent
violation and intent to assess forfeiture.

Good morning, everyone. My name is Sarah
Parrot. I'm the attorney examiner assigned by the
Commission to hear this case.

I would note that this is a continuation of
the hearing which originally convened on
September 7, 2017. One of the respondents,
Mr. Savoie, was unable to attend the hearing due to
illness, and in light of that fact, neither of the
respondents appeared on the 7th of September. At
their request, though, the hearing has been
continued to this morning. I would note that
neither of the respondents is present in the room at
this time.

Let's go ahead and take appearances from
the Staff, though. Mr. Lindgren.

MR. LINDGREN: Thank you. On behalf of

1 the Commission Staff, the Office of Ohio Attorney
2 General Mike DeWine, by Thomas G. Lindgren,
3 Assistant Attorney General. The address is 30 East
4 Broad Street, 16th Floor, Columbus, Ohio 42315.

5 THE ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Mr. Lindgren,
6 have you heard from the respondents in advance of
7 the hearing this morning?

8 MR. LINDGREN: No, I have not, Your
9 Honor. I attempted to contact them but was unable
10 to do so.

11 THE ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Thank you. I
12 have not heard from either of the respondents
13 either, but at this time, we will take a brief
14 recess and allow some time for one or both of the
15 respondents to appear at the hearing this morning.

16 So let's go off the record.

17 (Recess taken.)

18 THE ATTORNEY EXAMINER: It's
19 approximately 10:56 a.m. During our recess, I
20 returned to my office and did, at about 10:45 a.m.,
21 receive a phone call from Ricky Savoie on behalf of
22 the respondents saying that, although he had
23 received the Commission's entry scheduling the
24 hearing for today, he wasn't entirely sure, I guess,
25 whether or not it was, in fact, going forward on

1 today's date. Therefore, he is not -- and neither
2 is Mr. Culver -- prepared to be here for the hearing
3 today.

4 So I think we will just leave it at that.
5 I do thank both of Staff's witnesses for appearing
6 again today and being prepared to go forward, but I
7 think we're done.

8 Anything else from Staff before I adjourn
9 the hearing?

10 MR. LINDGREN: No, nothing, Your Honor.

11 THE ATTORNEY EXAMINER: All right.

12 Well, with that, I thank you again, and we are
13 adjourned.
