Discount Power intends to purchase both Solar and Non-Solar RECs from generators who have been certified as renewable from PUCO, have joined an approved REC registry, and will transfer RECs from the generator's account to the Discount Power account.

Discount Power has used internal forecasting methods to forecast our retail sales load over the next ten years, and has multiplied the annual sales by the current Ohio Alternate Energy Portfolio Standard requirements.
