Staff finds the concerns raised by the Applicant regarding the wording of Condition 3 to be reasonable, and presents its revised wording of Condition 3 in this supplement to the Staff Report of Investigation.

The following revised condition supersedes and replaces Condition 3 set forth in the Staff Report filed on February 20, 2018:

(3) Damaged lawns, sidewalks, driveways, and parking areas shall be restored to original conditions upon completion of construction, and monitored and restored, to the original preconstruction condition, for two years after the line has been placed in service. Unless otherwise directed by the property owner, concrete panels (if applicable) shall be replaced in their entirety rather than cut and patched.

With the conditions set forth in the February 20, 2018 Staff Report, as revised by the revisions set forth herein, Staff recommends approval of this case.
