- Q. Sir, if you would please state your name and by whom you are employed and in what capacity, please.
- A. My name is Steve Morgan, I am a

 Motor Carrier Enforcement Officer for the State

 of Ohio.

- A. Okay. Violations I found, the reason I stopped the vehicle was because he had no -- stop lights on the trailer were staying on. And you couldn't tell when he was stopping or anything like this. That was an out of service violation.

The next out of service violation was he was towing automobiles. And the one automobile on the bottom just only had one securement on it. It should have at least two.

So I wrote him up for that as another out of service violation.

Then he had multiple lights out and had multiple violations on logbook.
