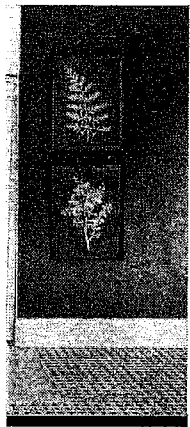
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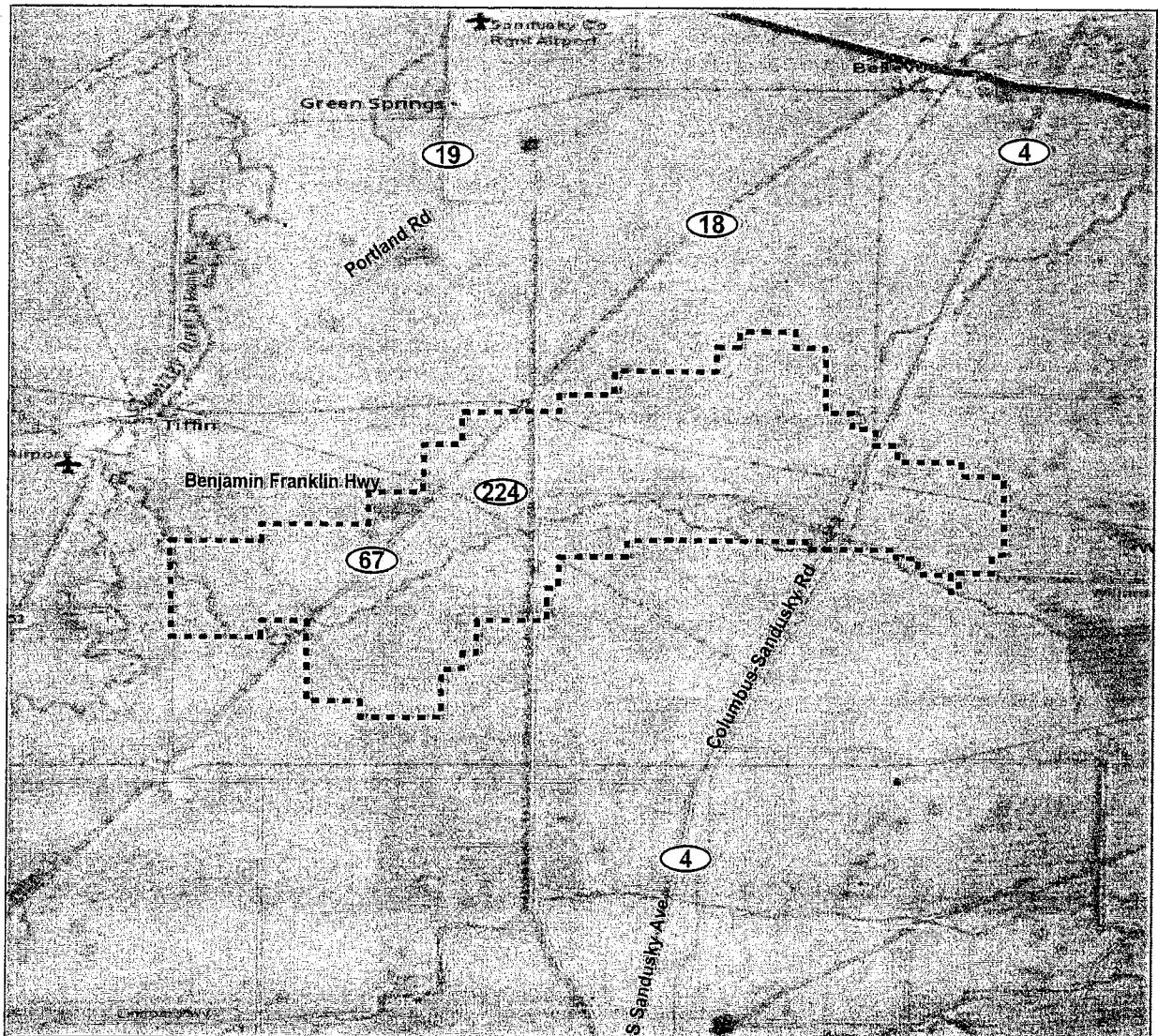
Notice of Public Informational Meeting for Proposed Major Utility Facility

Seneca Wind, LLC Schedules April 17, 2018 for a Public Meeting to Outline Plans for up to a 200 Megawatt Wind Farm To Be Located in Seneca County, Ohio.

Seneca Wind, LLC invites residents of Scipio, Reed, Venice, Eden, and Bloom Townships, Seneca County, Ohio, and other interested members of the public, to attend a public informational meeting regarding the company's plans to build up to a 200 megawatt wind farm.

The project will be built on approximately 25,000 acres of leased private land in Scipio, Reed, Venice, Eden, and Bloom Townships, Seneca County. The wind farm will consist of up to 70 wind turbine generators, along with access roads, electric collection cables, a substation, a laydown yard for construction staging, an operations and maintenance facility, and two meteorological towers. The nameplate capacity rating of these wind turbine generators ranges from 2.30 to 3.83 megawatts, depending on the final turbine model selected. The total generating capacity of the wind farm will not exceed 200 megawatts. The energy generated at the wind farm will deliver power to a single point of interconnection on the AEP Melmore 138 kilovolt transmission line. Construction of the project is projected to begin in April of 2019, with projected commercial operation in December of 2019.

The public informational meeting will take place from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m., on April 17, 2018 at the at the Camden Falls Reception and Conference Center located at 2460 OH-231, Tiffin, OH 44883. The meeting format will be an open house with stations containing information about the project presented on informational boards located throughout the room. Maps of the project area will be available to review. Company representatives will be available at each station to answer questions. Those who attend the meeting may submit written comments that the applicant will summarize, address and include in its application.
