On October 6, 2017, the Ohio Power Siting Board ("OPSB") Staff issued a Report of Investigation approving Dominion Energy Ohio's ("DEO") Construction Notice subject to a number of conditions. Within this set of conditions, Condition No. 3 requires DEO to submit a traffic plan, which shall include, but not be limited to maintaining traffic along public roadways and adjacent land uses during construction and notifying local government and emergency services of traffic and safety related issues.

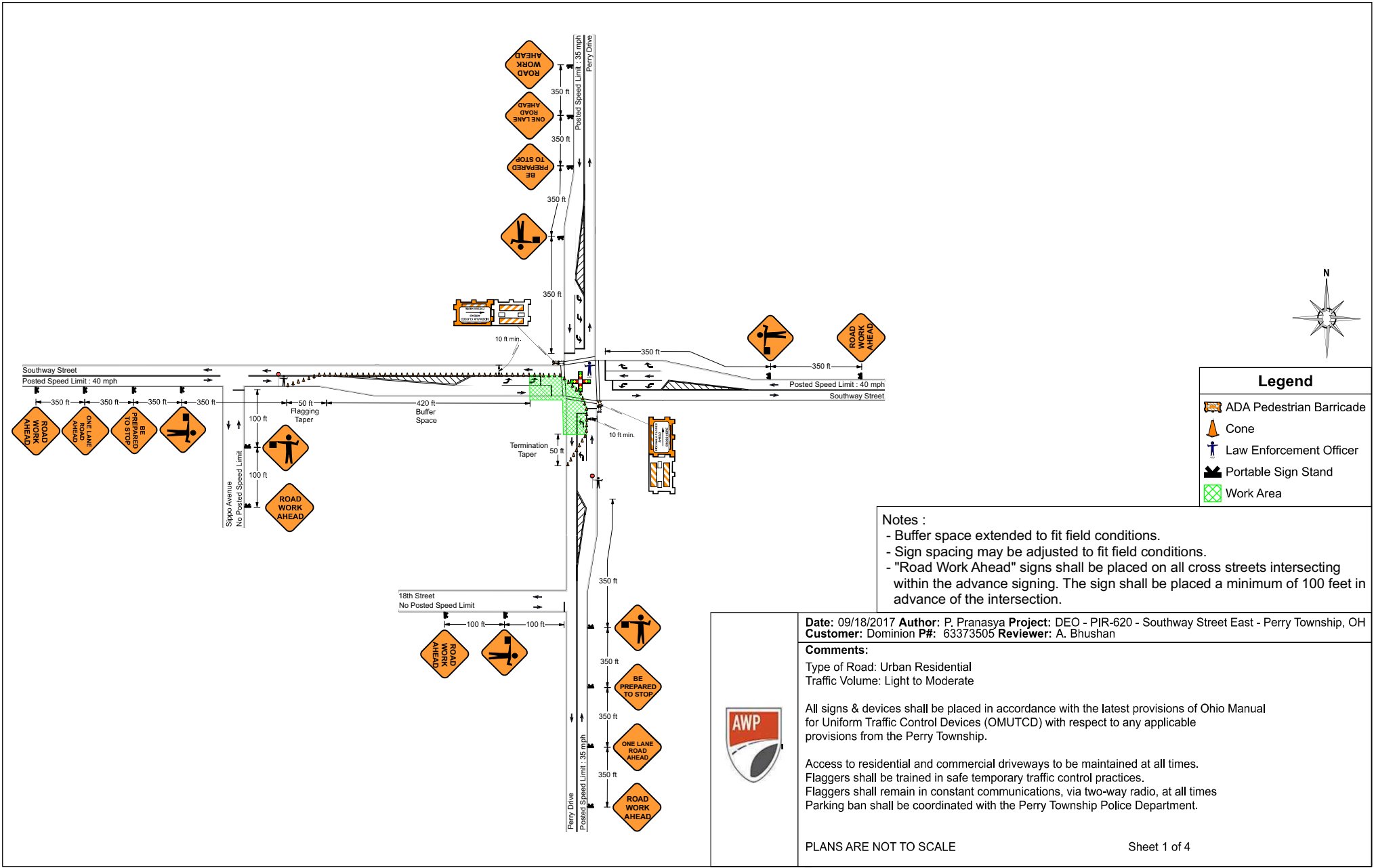

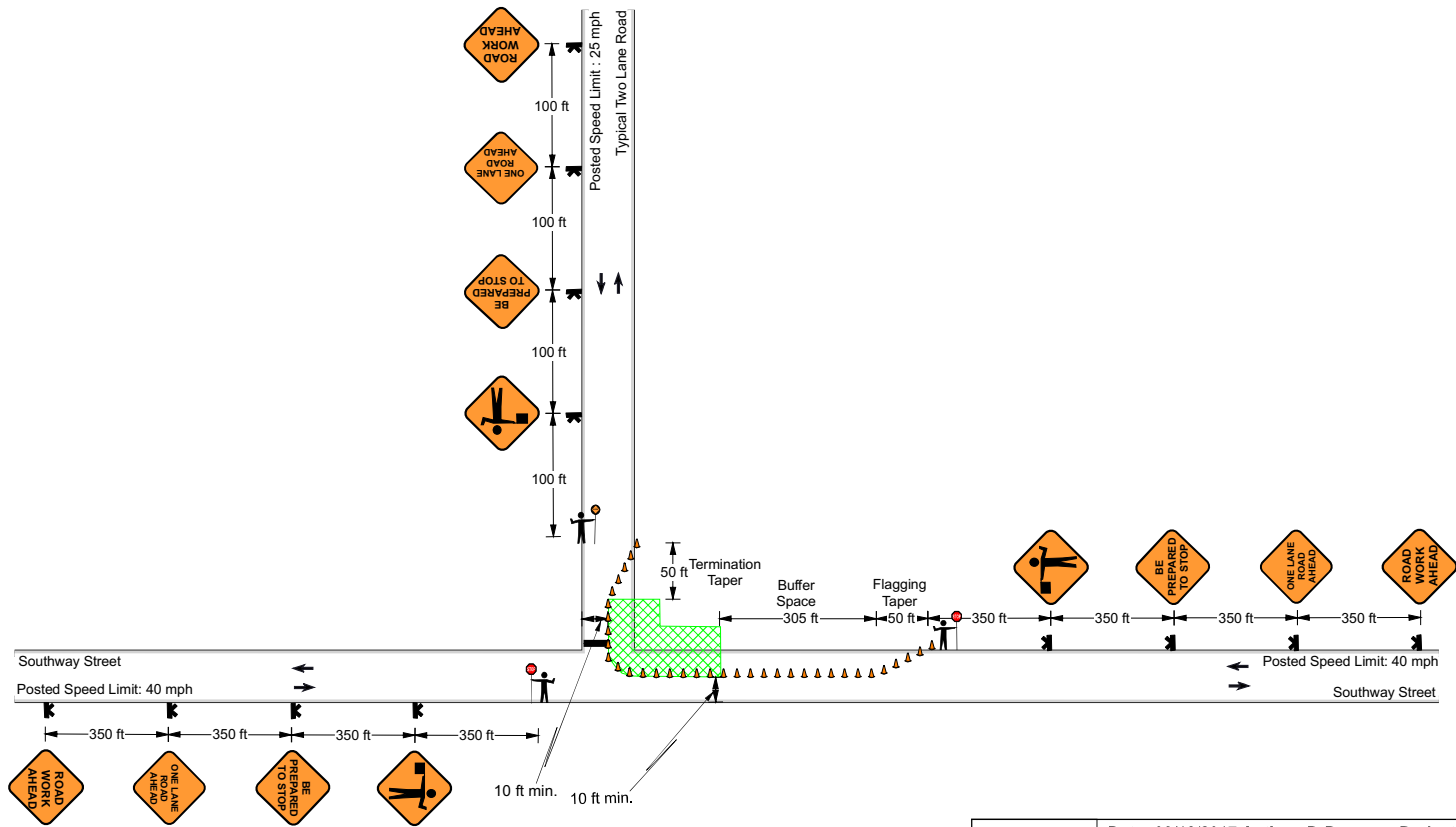

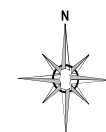

Dominion Energy Ohio (DEO) began construction of a 16" high pressure steel gas mainline replacement project (PIR-620 Southway–Perry) in Perry Township, Stark County on Southway Street between Westdale Street and Hopple Avenue on Thursday, May 17th. Don Wartko Construction Inc. (Wartko) is DEO's pipeline contractor for this project. Construction is scheduled to be completed by the middle to end of July, and restoration should be completed by early August. The project involves the temporary closure of the south lane of Southway Street while construction is ongoing. Traffic control will be provided by Area Wide Protective (AWP).
